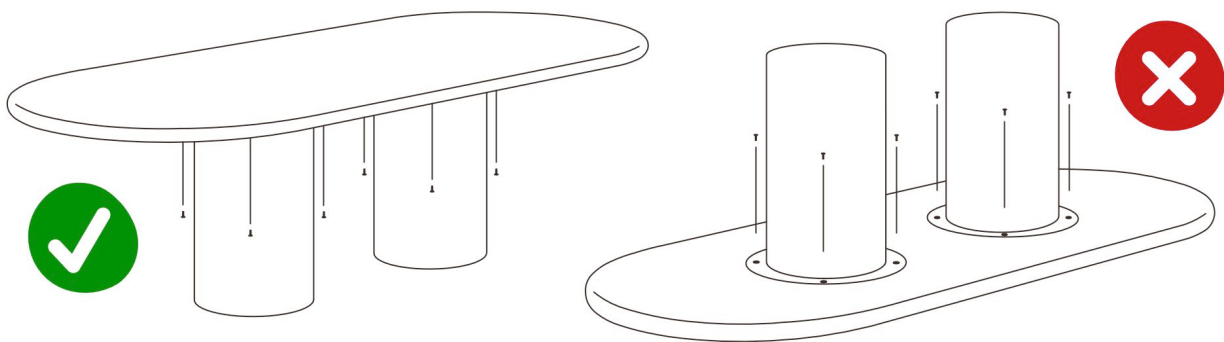


## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read these instructions carefully before starting assembly. BB United bv is not liable for damage or injury resulting from failure to follow these instructions.

### General guidelines

- Assembly requires 2-3 adults due to the size and weight of the parts. For tables longer than 3 meters, it is very important that the tabletop is supported in the middle when carried horizontally, to avoid stress or damage.
- Unpack on a soft, stable surface and use the protective bumpers from the packaging to protect the edges. Placing the tabletop on a hard surface without protection may cause scratches or dents.
- Assemble only on a hard, level floor.
- Tables must always be assembled *topside up* and fully disassembled before being moved or relocated.
- Only use the supplied tool and the supplied hardware provided with the table. Both are included in a package inside one of the table legs. The use of machines, power tools, or other tools may cause damage.



### Step-by-step instructions

1. Inspect the packaging for damage. Record any dents or scratches before unpacking.
2. Carefully remove the packaging and check all parts for damage. Report any issues in writing within 24 hours of delivery.
3. Ensure all screw holes in the tabletop and mounting plate are clean and free from dust or packing material.
4. Position the table legs exactly where the table will be placed.
5. With assistance, carefully lower the tabletop onto the legs. Puzzle the legs into position by lifting the tabletop slightly. Ensure that the screw holes are fully visible through the holes in the mounting plate.
6. Insert the screws and tighten them using only the provided tool. Screw until the screw head touches the mounting plate, then secure with a maximum additional 180° turn. Do not overtighten.

### Important

- Never use force. If screws do not go in smoothly, check the alignment of the holes.
- If necessary, apply a small amount of lubricant oil to help the screws turn smoothly.
- After assembly, verify that the table is stable, and all screws are secure.
- Always disassemble the table before moving it to avoid damage.
